This material contrasts beautifully when accented with white recessed grips intentionally used to create a handleless look.





White horizontal shelves, worktops and side panels form frames that complement the dark wood finishing, brightening up the area instantly.





are shown off on designer panels. Maybe the solution to inner peace is not to be found on the top of the mountain, but in the kitchen, after all!




## **RUSTIC COUNTRY**
